

The Implementation Checklist

Build The Campaign Shell

Step 1: Name the Campaign

Quick Tips

- 1. ##. Division Campaign Name.
- 2. Or Machine ##. Division Campaign name.

Step 2: Copy Milestones/Follow-up to Goals/Sequences in Campaign Builder

- 1. Start at "B2"
- 2. 1 full square between elements (2 if there's a decision diamond between them).

Step 3: Add Start and Stop Buttons

- 1. Replace the first goal with a start button.
- 2. Add a decision diamond after the start button.
- 3. Add a sequence after the first goal to push the start button.
- 4. Add a stop button to the end.
- 5. Add a sequence after the stop button to remove people from the play.

Step 4: Add an Internal Form

- 1. Name = Campaign Name: Update Form.
- 2. Add checkboxes to Start and Stop the play.
- 3. Add sequences from the internal form to Start and Stop the play.

Configure The Campaign Details

Step 1: Create Your Tags

- 1. This is not a creative exercise.
- 2. Use The Tagger.

Step 2: Configure Your Goals

1. This is pretty self-explanatory. Just do it.

Step 3: Configure Your Sequences

- 1. Add your Status and History track.
 - a. First remove ALL statuses in the play.
 - b. Then apply the appropriate status.
 - c. Then apply any applicable history tags.



- 2. Add your Systems and Integration track.
 - a. Remove any system tags that may have been used to start the sequence.
 - b. Apply any other applicable system tags.
 - c. Run any HTTP posts for any integrations you might be using (like PlusThis, etc.)
- 3. Add your Marketing and To-Dos track
 - a. Copy this directly from your Executable Blueprint™.

Set up the Dashboards

Step 1: Create Your Saved Searches

- 1. This is not a creative exercise.
- 2. Create saved searches for all To-Do sensors
- 3. Create saved searches for All Statuses

Step 2: Create Your Dashboards

- 1. Top Left = Get These To 0 Before I Leave.
- 2. Middle/Right = Individual play summaries.
